

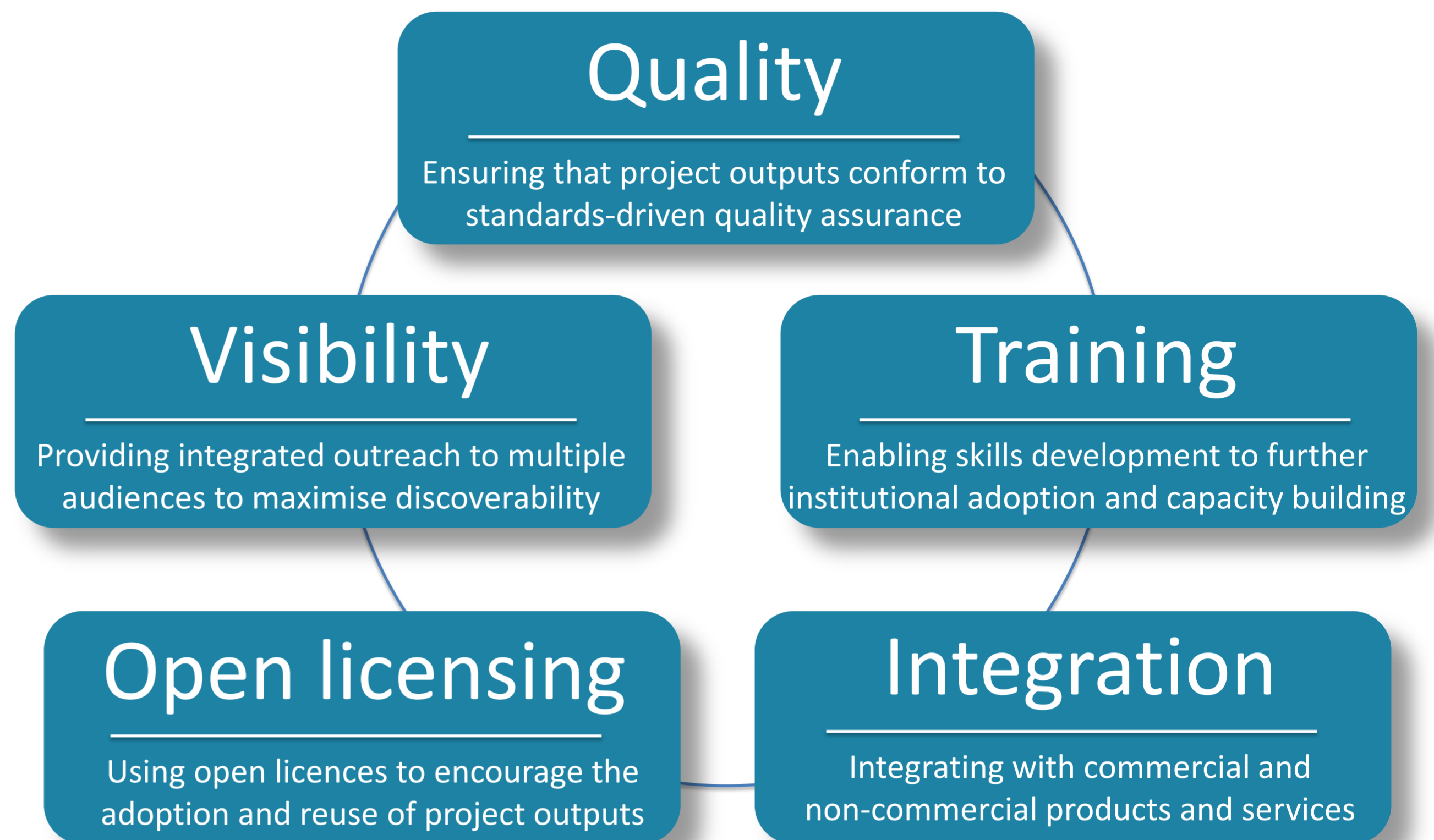
SCAPE: Long-term Sustainability

The SCAPE partners **collaborate with the wider community** to ensure long-term adoption and alignment with ongoing initiatives.



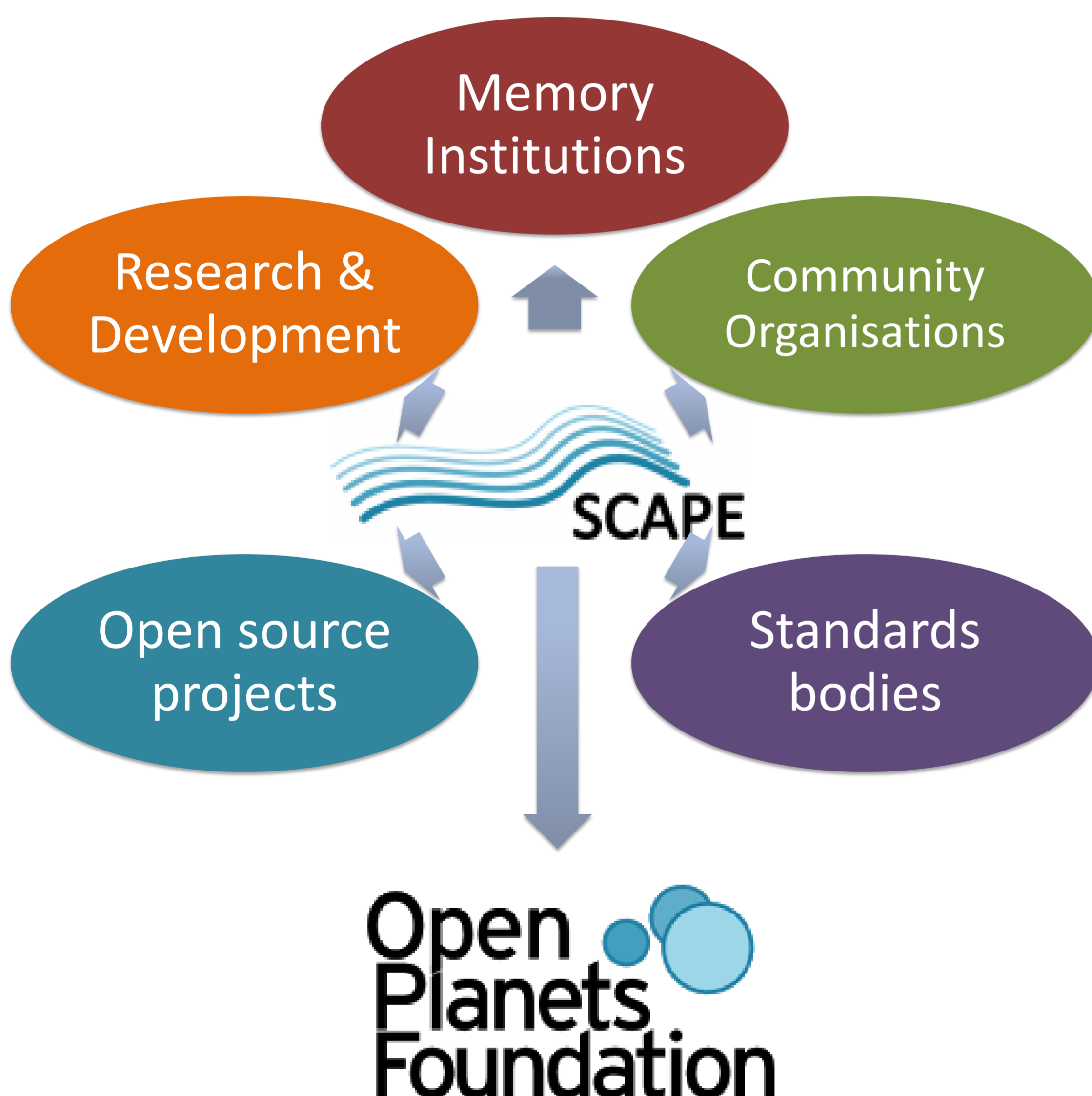
The **Open Planets Foundation** is responsible for looking after the outputs after project ends.
