This could take months...




SCAPE addresses scalability in four dimensions:

- Number of objects
- Size of objects
- Complexity of objects
- Heterogeneity of collections.

Avoid the waiting by scaling out and complete the task in just days

Example of scale-out processing.



Using several tracks to parallelise work – dividing workload, sorting work packages, and grouping into file formats.
